84% of African population is at risk of Malaria

In any one year, it is estimated that 210 to 230 million African people experience the fevers and chills of Malaria.

Ninety per cent of Malaria world deaths are in Africa (Table 3.1).

In Africa, 88% of Malaria deaths are children under five (Table 3.1).

The two countries with the highest number of malaria cases in millions in the world are Nigeria and DR Congo.
